2	Ensure that all classes are organised to provide optimum access to the curriculum for children with disabilities; and ensure relevant staff are confident in their use of SEND resources, including computing software.	2.1 The Head of Learning Support and subject teachers will ensure children have access to: Visual aids Visual timetables Symbols/pictures where needed Zones of Regulation charts Any other resources as identified on individual provision 2.2 The Head of Learning Support will identify training needs. 3	Improving access to the physical environment of the School.	3.1 Whenever current facilities are refurbished, every opportunity will be taken to incorporate services for the disabled wherever possible.
