

Scholarships are available for entry into in September 2024. In Years 3-6, they are only available to families who are not already part of the Vinehall community. 11+ scholarships are available to both external and existing Year 6 children.

Scholarships are competitive with practical and written entry assessments taking place in **Lent Term 2024**.

All children are automatically assessed for an Academic Scholarship through the tests they sit on their assessment day. The tests will consist of English, Maths and a short piece of creative writing. We do not recommend any tutoring for the tests as they are designed to look for potential rather than previous attainment.

- A confidential reference from a child's current school will be sought prior to the assessment day.
- Children who are talented in sport, music, drama or art may also offer a maximum of two elements for practical assessment
- Children will be seen by teachers in the relevant departments and they are encouraged to submit supporting references /reports in advance.
- For children who perform soundly in the academic tests but demonstrate particular talent in another area, a specific scholar-ship in that area will be considered or alternatively, an all rounder scholarship.
- Scholarships are worth 10% of the basic fees and these are non means tested.
- Scholarships can be augmented by means tested bursary support. The level of financial assistance is determined by an assess-ment of parental means via completion of a Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances (bursary form).
