

## Aims and Ethos of Boarding at Vinehall School

## Boarding at Vinehall is based upon the following nine principles:

- 1. The formation of the whole person.
- 2. Being an open and trusting school, boarding is based upon mutual respect for all members.
- 3. Each boarder has the right to be able to work, play, and relax free from unacceptable behaviour, particularly teasing and bullying.
- 4. There is equality of opportunity and respect for all boarders, regardless of race, religion, culture or gender.
- 5. Each boarder and each member of staff is to be treated as an individual and with respect by other pupils and by staff.
- 6. Although living under one roof the staff and boarders acknowledge the right of each person to privacy.
- 7. Each boarder has the right to extend his/her intellectual growth in an atmosphere of positive encouragement and in conditions which are conducive to work.
- 8. All boarders should be able to develop spiritually, culturally, morally and socially during his/her time in boarding.
- 9. Despite the often great distance separating boarders from their families, links with parents are seen as an indispensable part of the support and development of boarders in this school.
