Vinehall uniform is supplied by Simmonds.

General

1. Ensure all clothing and all personal items are in good repair and marked clearly with woven name tapes and/or the pupils' number. The Matrons cannot be held responsible for unmarked items going missing. Please do not use the iron-on name tapes – they come off!
2. Sew STRONG loops (thick tape or elastic) onto all items indicated 'Loop' on the uniform list. A charge will be made if clothing is not marked or looped.
3. Ensure that boots and shoes are very clearly marked with the child's school number. Gym shoes, trainers, wellington boots and football/hockey/rugby boots should be marked with the pupil number, in permanent black or silver ink, on the outside with the name on the inside.
4. Engrave your child's pen, watch, Ipod etc with the pupil number. Pencil case equipment should also be clearly named.
5. GIRLS: Girls are expected to have skirt lengths to the knee, no more, no less please! Please ensure that sensible school shoes are purchased.
6. BOYS: Ensure that your son has neat hair and has visited the hairdresser before term begins and that the style is traditional, off the collar and not extreme. A further visit at half term is strongly recommended. Hair dye is not permitted. Weekly checks for head lice are carried out!
6. GIRLS: Ensure that your daughter has neat hair. If it is long she will be required to have it tied back for school. dye is not permitted. Weekly checks for head lice are carried out!
7. Prep School: Boys are permitted to wear a crucifix and chain. Other jewellery is not allowed.
8. Prep School: Girls may have one pair of small plain silver or gold stud earrings and a crucifix and chain. Other jewellery is not allowed. Jewellery MUST be removed before any sports activities.
