



ACCESSIBILITY PLAN: 1 SEPT 2018 – 31 AUG 2021

Improvements have been made in the preceding years, in line with the recommendations contained in the Access Audit Report and the availability of funds.

As has been stated above, there will be immediate and significant development in accessibility where it is agreed that reasonable adjustments can be made in the event of a disabled pupil or member of staff joining the School.

However, even if this does not happen, the School will continue to increase the facilities for the disabled whenever possible.
